We also provide personalized bags of new clothing to preschool children through the Early Childhood Educational Assistance Program (ECEAP). Currently, we have long-standing agreements with 15 school districts throughout Snohomish County. Every child receives: 3 pairs of jeans, pants or leggings, 1 jacket, 1 sweatshirt, 3 shirts, 6 pairs of underwear, 6 pairs of socks, 1 personal hygiene care kit, 1 pair of shoes, 1 book of their choice.</p>
