Currently, we have long-standing agreements with 15 school districts throughout Snohomish County. Every child receives: 3 pairs of jeans, pants or leggings, 1 jacket, 1 sweatshirt, 3 shirts, 6 pairs of underwear, 6 pairs of socks, 1 personal hygiene care kit, 1 pair of shoes, 1 book of their choice.</p>

<p>Housing Hope - Housing Hope offers a full range of affordable housing options throughout Snohomish County. Housing types include emergency shelter, transitional housing, affordable rent units and homeownership opportunities. Housing Hope focuses its activities on Snohomish County and Camano Island, collaborating and cooperating with local communities to make sure programs address the needs of local residents with the lowest incomes and the greatest need.</p> <p>Since 1987, sixty-eight housing developments have been completed. Housing Hope currently manages 479 units in 22 housing developments and has helped 301 families build and own their own homes through our sweat equity program. Our programs are successful. As one example, more than 90% of the families who "graduate" from the transitional housing program go on to obtain long-term stable housing.</p>	<p>Learn more</p>

It is designed to help feed hungry school-aged children who are currently on the National School Lunch Program by providing them with supplemental food for the weekends and school holidays. Many students are getting enough to eat at school during the week through the National School Lunch Program. However, when they are home on the weekends there often is not enough food. Supplemental kid-friendly food items are packaged in nondescript bags that are distributed to students at school on Fridays.
